## **POSITION SUMMARY**

The Ambassador is a critical field team member of The Global Orphan Project's domestic ministry and the CarePortal (CP) Platform. This leader serves as a local expert responsible for recruiting and equipping local churches. Specifically, the Ambassador will (a) help identify local church partners in the identified area(s); (b) help develop and provide ongoing support to the local network of engaged churches who will meet the needs of the vulnerable, walking with them at the point of care, and (c) engage other businesses and individuals in community partnerships for the benefit of children and families. The role requires relational, operational, and managerial strengths to drive collaboration across partner ministries, denominations, and child welfare agencies.

## **MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO)**

### **Recruitment and Requesting Church Development**

- Recruit new churches into their network and serve as the primary point of contact to help each church get activated on the CarePortal platform.
- Develop new community partnerships who want to partner with the Church to respond to local requests.
- Engage and equip current churches and other responders to use the CarePortal platform to go deeper in their efforts and maturity as they work together to meet local requests.

### **Partner and Agency Support**

- Mobilize, train, and support participating churches and agencies in the region as supported by the Regional Manager
- Work collaboratively with partners and agencies to increase Church engagement and to extend ministry reach
- Regularly recommend ministry innovations and platform improvements to the Global Ministry Support team
